# Investing in young people and our community

A community based work project under the Matariki strategy is set to give young people a pathway to employment.

# Who is eligible?

The project aims to actively include young people who experience health conditions or disability in project based work where they can develop; employment skills, experience and on the job training.

# What projects are eligible?

Projects can be up to 26 weeks with the expectation that this experience will assist young people to progress towards sustainable employment.

The projects will:

- be for community or environmental good
- · cannot displace a worker
- be over and above business as usual

### Participating project sponsors will need to:

- Identify community projects
- Apply to participate in the programme
- Organise the project
- Provide materials
- · Provide a safe and healthy work environment
- Work with the partners to move young people into work.

### What support is available?

The partners will stay in touch with both the participant and project sponsor to make sure everything is running smoothly during their placement and there is a pathway to sustainable employment.

Mentoring and support will be provided to participants.
